Professor Dr. Eri Ota (Professor of Science University of Tokyo) was appointed as a Visiting Professor for LNBTI

Prof. Dr. Eri Ota has a strong academic background and extensive work experience in global environmental studies, international education, and policy research.

Education: Prof. Ota obtained a Ph.D. in Global Environmental Studies from Sophia University in Tokyo, Japan (2008), with a dissertation on environmental education and German climate policy. Prior to that, she earned a Master of Arts in International Environmental Policy from the Monterey Institute of International Studies, USA (1997), and a Bachelor of Arts in Political Economy from Pitzer College in California, USA (1995).

Work Experience: Prof. Ota spans a variety of educational and research roles, with a particular focus on global education and environmental policy. Currently, she is a Specially Appointed Professor at the Center for Entrepreneurship Education, University of Science Tokyo (October 2024-Present), where they focus on global education within entrepreneurship.

From April 2015 to September 2024, Prof. Ota served as a Specially Appointed Professor and University Education Administrator at the Tokyo Institute of Technology, managing global human resource development, especially through the Global Scientists and Engineers Course. Earlier, Prof. Ota worked as a Specially Appointed Associate Professor at the Promotion Office for Global Scientists and Engineers (2013-2015), where she helped launch and develop the Global Scientists and Engineers Course. Prof. Ota also served as a researcher at the Ocean Policy Research Foundation (2010-2012), focusing on integrated coastal zone management and ocean education.

Prof. Ota has also held positions in public relations, program management, and literacy promotion, including with UNESCO's Asia/Pacific Cultural Centre, where they focused on environmental education.
