The Vice Chancellor's Message

Believe in Yourself and Keep Striving: You will be the next to create dreams for young Sri Lankans

The world is constantly changing, and not all change is easy to understand at the beginning. In such times, one of the most important qualities we can have is the courage to believe in ourselves and continue our efforts.

I am often reminded of Professor Isamu Akasaki, whom I knew during my time at Meijo University. In 2014, he received the Nobel Prize in Physics for the invention of the blue LED. This discovery made white LED lighting possible and has had a major positive impact on society through energy-efficient and long-lasting lighting.

What is most inspiring is that his success did not come easily. As a young researcher, he once obtained a different result from other students in a physics experiment. While others passed by following the guidebook, he alone was marked as “failed” because his result did not match the expected answer. However, instead of giving up, he kept asking, “Why was my result different?” He continued his research with persistence, while listening to some opinions to discontinue the useless research activities which will create no value. Nevertheless, in time, his efforts changed the world. We now enjoy the impacts of the low-cost and low-power consuming LED lights, thanks to the continued effort of Professor Akasaki.

There is a powerful lesson in this story: believe in yourself, continue your efforts, and develop the ability to judge what is truly valuable.

This lesson also reminds me of the students who joined LNBTI in its early years. LNBTI introduced a unique educational model in Sri Lanka—studying IT and Japanese together, and preparing for employment in Japan after graduation. At first, many people did not understand this vision. Some students doubted it, and many left.

Yet a number of students chose to stay. Despite uncertainty, they trusted the LNBTI vision and continued learning. They worked hard to build both IT knowledge and Japanese language ability. As a result, in their final year, they received job offers from Japanese companies and are now preparing to start their careers in Japan. If my schedule permits, I will accompany our first batch of these happy graduates on the same flight to Japan.

This is more than a personal achievement. It is proof that a new path, when pursued with courage and effort, can create real opportunities and hope.

Guiding to secure a job before graduation is unique to LNBTI. The job is in Japanese companies, not local Sri Lankan IT companies. It is because we train you for the Japanese IT industry. In other universities, students are guided to acquire a degree. Society will eventually learn this special characteristic of the unique and pioneering academic model of LNBTI.

To all our students, I encourage you: do not be discouraged by rumors or temporary uncertainty. If you have questions, speak to your lecturers and staff. Seek accurate information and make decisions with wisdom and confidence. Be proud of your decision to join LNBTI. You will be one of the next smiling faces at the time of graduation: thanks to the job offer you will have received even before the graduation.

Above all, believe in yourself, believe in your learning journey at LNBTI, and keep striving. Your effort today will open doors tomorrow, not only for your own future, but also for the many students who will follow in your footsteps.

LNBTI will continue to support you as you learn, grow, and build the future.
