In today's digital world, social networking services, or SNS, have become an important part of young people's daily lives. Platforms such as Facebook, Instagram, TikTok, X, and LinkedIn are widely used for communication, sharing ideas, and building networks. However, for students who hope to study or work in Japan, responsible SNS usage is very important.

In Sri Lanka, many people often forward messages, posts, or videos shared by others without fully checking their accuracy or meaning. Open criticism on SNS is also common, including criticism of friends, political leaders, social leaders, organizations, and institutions. Although these actions may seem casual, they can create misunderstandings and negatively affect a person's image.

As the first and only Japanese higher education institute with degree-awarding status in Sri Lanka, LNBTI encourages its students and readers to pay attention to these cultural differences. LNBTI students have great potential to join Japanese companies after completing their degrees, provided they meet the necessary academic requirements, IT skills, Japanese language competency, JLPT/NAT qualifications beyond N3 level, and successfully pass job-related tests and interviews.

Therefore, students are encouraged to use SNS wisely and professionally. Before sharing, commenting, criticizing, or forwarding any content, they should think carefully about whether it is accurate, respectful, and suitable for their future career image.

With the right skills, language ability, professional attitude, and responsible SNS behavior, students can confidently prepare for a successful future in Japan.

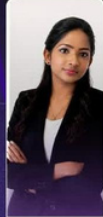
